We are an overnight camp in the Pocono Mountains, PA, where children come for 7 full weeks away from home. While the campers enjoy an array of activities from sports, arts, aquatics and adventure, **the Canadensis Today Show broadcasts online to hundreds of families** at home that want to share in the special summer memories. The show has become an integral part of our connection to families and our marketing strategy.

Job Description:

- Records and edits material to produce a daily, 15-minute web show and video segments throughout the summer. This position is involved in the entire process from concept through post-production.
- Operates a video camera and keeps it nearby at all time to capture footage.
- Creates concepts for the show and takes pieces through the entire production cycle.
- Captures on film as much of the summer excitement as possible! Early mornings, late nights, unique locations! Must be willing to go anywhere and maintain a flexible work schedule in order to get the content!
- Must have a working knowledge of how to setup lighting, audio, and prep the set/subjects.
- Will work with small groups of campers (ages 9-15) daily, must feel confident teaching them basic video skills, and how to create segments for the Canadensis Today Show.
- Must be able to competently use Final Cut Pro to edit and assemble the final version of the Canadensis Today Show that will be uploaded daily.
- Writes daily script outlines for the co-anchors of the show.
- Creates moving text and graphics to help with the flow and aesthetic of the show.
- Captures b-roll footage to accompany the show.
- Acquires and selects music for the Canadensis Today Show and 411 “music video” pieces.
- Must possess a keen editing eye to make sure we are always presenting a high quality program to our families, with appropriate footage/language/music.
- Must be able to take creative ideas and turn it into actual segments that will air on the show.
- Strong organizational skills and the ability to work quickly to turn around material in a news-like, journalistic way.
- Enjoy working with children in an outdoor environment.
